Cemal Ucer graduated from Manchester Dental School in 1982. After postgraduate training as an oral surgeon he has established a private referral practice for implantology, in 1988. During the past 20 years, he has carried out thousands of implant procedures using different implant systems including Astra, Branemark, ITI/ Straumann and Sweden Martina.

He is dedicated to long term dental research and education and was awarded one of the first MSc degrees in implantology in the UK at Manchester University after two years of study, in 1995. His special clinical interests are into guided bone regeneration. osteopromotion and biomechanical loading of implants. His academic interests include developing a framework for assessment of clinical competencies in implant dentistry as well as training and calibration of mentors.

He was awarded a PhD degree at Manchester University for his study investigating the factors affecting the survival of implants in iliac bone grafts and osteoporotic patients.

He is a co-author of an international, multi-centre, 5-year prospective clinical trial which investigated the long term success of dental implants in fresh extraction sites (2013). Currently, he is involved in developing an online system aimed at monitoring the success of implant treatment based on patient reported outcomes (PROMS).

His other research interests include the role of bone quality and density in determining the primary stability and success of implants, GBR and sinus grafting techniques.

He has lectured in implantology since the 1990's and runs a private referral practice limited to oral surgery and implantology at Oaklands Hospital in Manchester, Cemal has been running the Multi-System Course since the early 90's and as the course organiser provides on-going clinical support and expertise to the course delegates throughout the year course. He is on the specialist list of Oral Surgery and has a professorial appointment as the Clinical Lead of the MSc programme in Implantology at Edge Hill University. Cemal is a past president of the Association of Dental Implantology (2011-2013), Fellow of the International Team for Implantology (ITI), and clinical director of ICE Postgraduate Studies in Implant Dentistry at the University of Edge Hill in Liverpool. He has contributed to the scientific literature with numerous guidelines, position and research papers and general publications. He is a cheif author of the ADEE position paper on CPD Education in Implant Dentistry in Europe (2014) and a member of the panel which revised the FGDP Training Standards in Implant Dentistry in 2012.



Cemal is an invited member of the Association of Dental Education in Europe (ADEE) working group convened to establish training and assessment standards in implant dentistry in Europe. He is a member of the Faculty of Examiners for the newly established RCSEd Diploma in Implant Dentistry. Cemal also runs mentor training programmes in which he trains trainers in implant dentistry in 2012.
